**Preparation Instructions:**

You are scheduled for a colonoscopy, a procedure in which a doctor examines the lining of your large intestine by looking through a flexible tube called a colonoscope. If growths or other abnormalities are found during the procedure, the doctor may remove the abnormal tissue for closer examination or biopsy. . **If this is a screening colonoscopy and a polyp is removed or other abnormalities revealed, YOUR CO-PAY WILL CHANGE.** Contact your insurance company to see what your out of pocket expenses will be.

**Please remember to arrange for a responsible adult to stay with you during your procedure and drive you home. If you do not have a responsible adult your procedure will be cancelled and rescheduled. Please review the preparation schedule below for the days preceding your colonoscopy. <p>✓ Pick up Halflytely prescription from your pharmacy.</p> <p><u>Optional - for sore bottom:</u> - Plain or Aloe Baby Wipes - Desitin or A&amp;D ointment</p> <p>▶ Arrange for a responsible adult to stay with you during the procedure and take you home post procedure.</p> <p>▶ If you take medications containing iron discontinue those <b>7 days</b> before your appointment. This includes multivitamins with iron.</p> <p>▶ Do not take oral hypoglycemics night before and morning of the procedure. (Actos, Metformin, Glyburide, Januvia, Glipizide)</p> <p>▶ If you are on insulin, half the dosage the night before the procedure.</p> <p>▶ <u>Stop taking these meds:</u> Advil, Ibuprofen, Aleve.</p> <p><b>Plavix or Coumadin (if okay with your cardiologist).</b></p> <p><b>Tylenol is okay to take.</b></p>	<p>▶ <b>Begin clear liquid diet.</b> Includes: Water, broth, coffee or tea without milk or creamer, Gatorade, soft drinks, juices (no pulp), Jell-O.</p> <p>No dairy. <b>Do not eat or drink anything red, blue, or purple.</b></p> <p>Drink at least 8 large glasses of water throughout the day.</p> <p>➤ <b>12:00 noon:</b> Take the tablet that came in the Halflytely Prep Kit. Mix solution and place in refrigerator if desired.</p> <p>➤ <b>5 pm:</b> Drink 8 oz of solution and continue drinking an 8 oz glass of solution every 15 minutes until the solution is finished.</p> <p><b>If you experience nausea or vomiting take a 15-30 minute break, then continue drinking prep solution.</b></p> <p><b><u>Nothing to eat or drink after midnight!</u></b></p>	<p>▶ You may take your essential morning medications with a few small sips of water, unless otherwise directed by your physician.</p> <p>▶ <b>Be sure to bring the following:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Responsible adult driver to stay with you and drive you home</li> <li>✓ Insurance Cards</li> <li>✓ Any co insurance fees due</li> <li>✓ Driver’s License</li> <li>✓ Medical Directive</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Scheduling Information:</u></b> <b><u>901-4496</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Clinical Information:</u></b> <b><u>901-4715</u></b></p> <p><b>NOTE: There will be a \$75 charge if you cancel your procedure within 3 business days of your scheduled date.</b></p>
